PROGRAM TO ELECTRONICALLY FILE
PROOF OF CLAIM/WITHDRAWAL OF CLAIM
WITHOUT A CM/ECF LOGIN

This Court has implemented the Electronic Proof of Claims (ePOC) Program, which allows creditors to electronically file a proof of claim and/or withdrawal of claim in all cases through the Court's website without a CM/ECF login/password.

The ePOC program, when electronically filing a proof of claim, allows:

- the party to populate and electronically file a B10 proof of claim form with the Court,
- the party to attach supplemental documentation to the proof of claim form,
- the party to populate and electronically file an amended B10 proof of claim form with the Court.

The ePOC program, when electronically filing a withdrawal of claim, allows:

- the party to attach and electronically file a completed withdrawal of claim PDF.

Links to the Electronic Proof of Claim (ePOC) Program to electronically file a proof of claim or withdrawal of claim are available on the Court's web site, www.ilsb.uscourts.gov.

Penalty for filing fraudulent claim: Fine of up to \$500,000 or imprisonment for up to 5 years, or both.
